

Fellow Marines and Navy Corpsmen of Hotel Company:

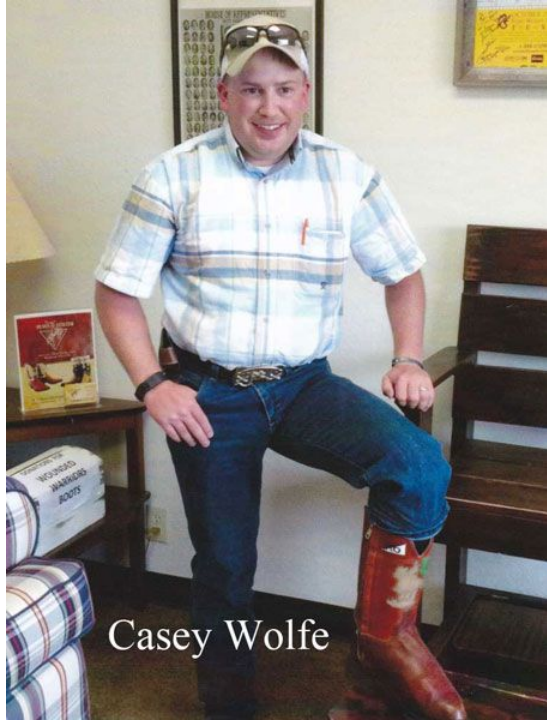

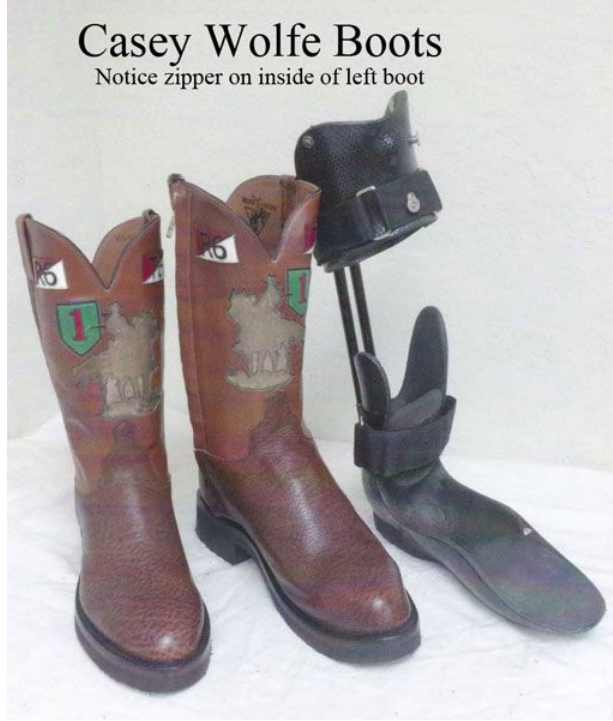

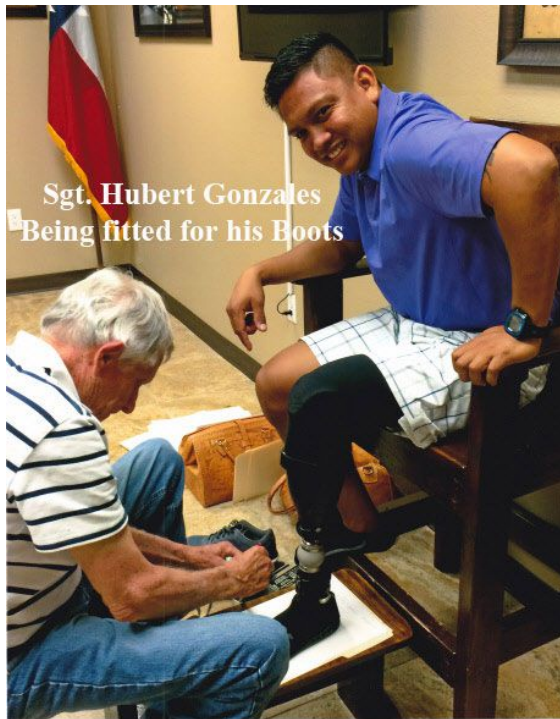
